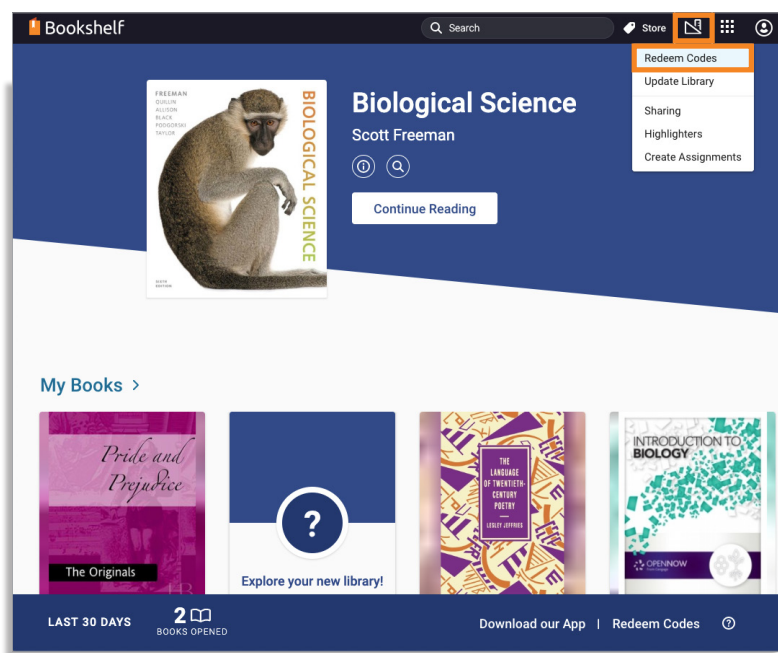


Redeem a Code in Bookshelf® Online

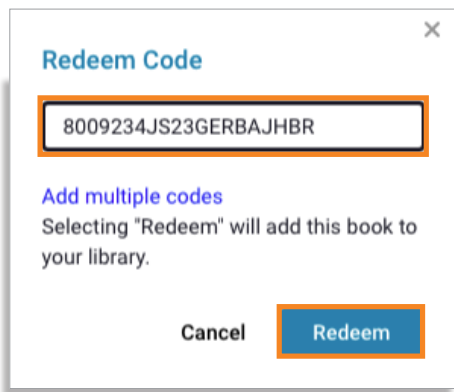
A Bookshelf code is generated to provide a user with access to content. These codes are typically comprised of 20 alphanumeric characters.

To redeem a code in Bookshelf Online:

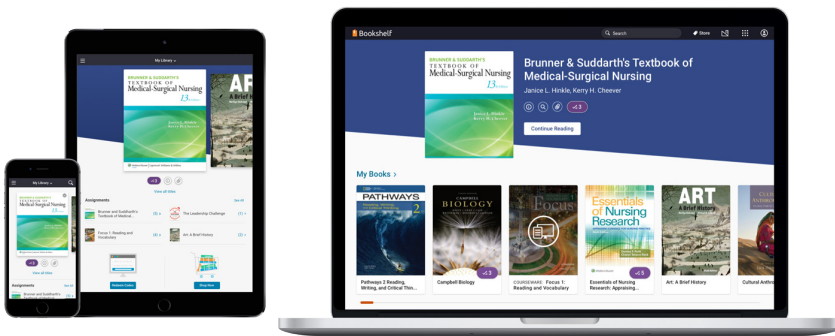
STEP 1: Click on Redeem in the toolbar at the top of the digital library to activate the menu.



STEP 2: When the Redeem menu appears, copy and paste the code in the entry field and click the blue Redeem button. Your digital library will update to reflect the addition of the new title. Note: Because the codes are a random combination of letters and numbers, it is best to copy the code from the email or document in which you received it to avoid making errors.

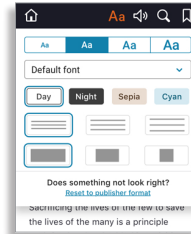


How to Download Bookshelf®

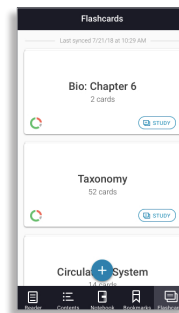

iOS

Available on iPad, iPhone, and iPods that support iOS 11+.

To download, open the App Store, search for Bookshelf, and install the app.



Android

Available on Android tablets and phones that support Android 5.0+.

To download, open the Google Play Store, search for Bookshelf, and install the app.



Amazon Fire

Available on Amazon Fire tablets and phones that support OS 5+.

To download, open the Amazon App Store, search for Bookshelf, and install the app.



Chromebook

Available on Chromebooks that support Android 5.0+ and have access to the Google Play Store.

To download, open the Google Play Store, search for Bookshelf, and install the app.



Mac

Available on Mac computers and laptops that support MacOS 10.12+.

To download, go to support.vitalsource.com and select Bookshelf Mac from the Download dropdown menu.

Windows

Available on PCs that support Windows 10.16299+ and have access to the Microsoft Store.

To download, open the MS Store on your Windows machine, search for Bookshelf, and click Get.

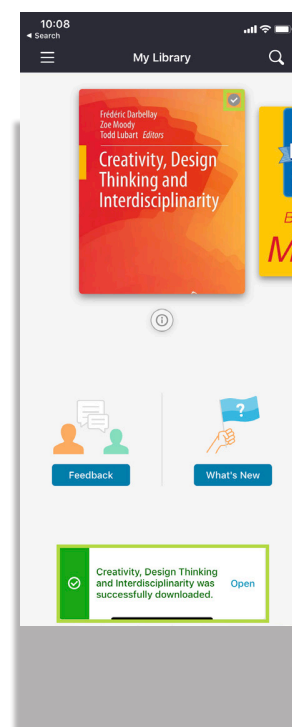
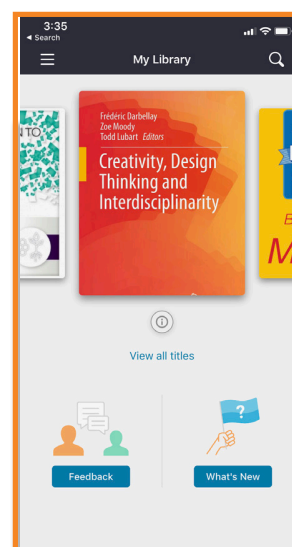
Your last page read, bookmarks, and annotations are automatically synced across all of your devices. Those synced annotations can be shared with your classmates for collaboration via highlighters and notes. Instructors can also share their own annotations with their classes to call out key concepts.

Mobile App

To download content to your mobile device from the Bookshelf app, simply click on the title you want to download while your phone or tablet is connected to the internet.

Once the content has downloaded, a small checkmark icon will appear in the top-right corner of the title on your homepage. A green dialogue box will appear at the bottom of your screen notifying you that the title has successfully downloaded.



Access Content Offline With Bookshelf Mobile and Desktop Apps

Desktop App

To download content to your PC or Mac from the Bookshelf desktop app, be sure you are connected to the internet. Hover your cursor over the title you want to download and click Download Book when it appears.

You will see a dialogue box appear as the content is downloading, and another to notify you when the download is complete.
