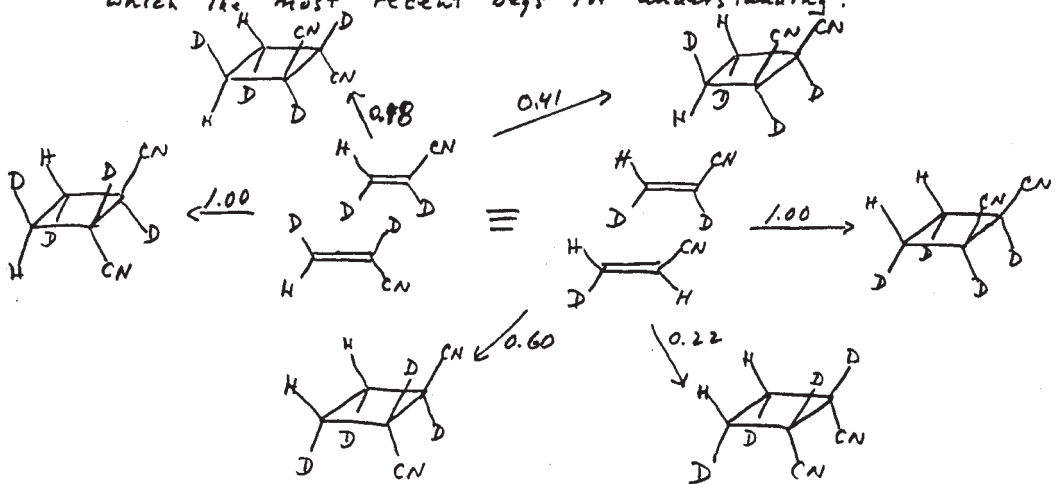


So many years since first we met
